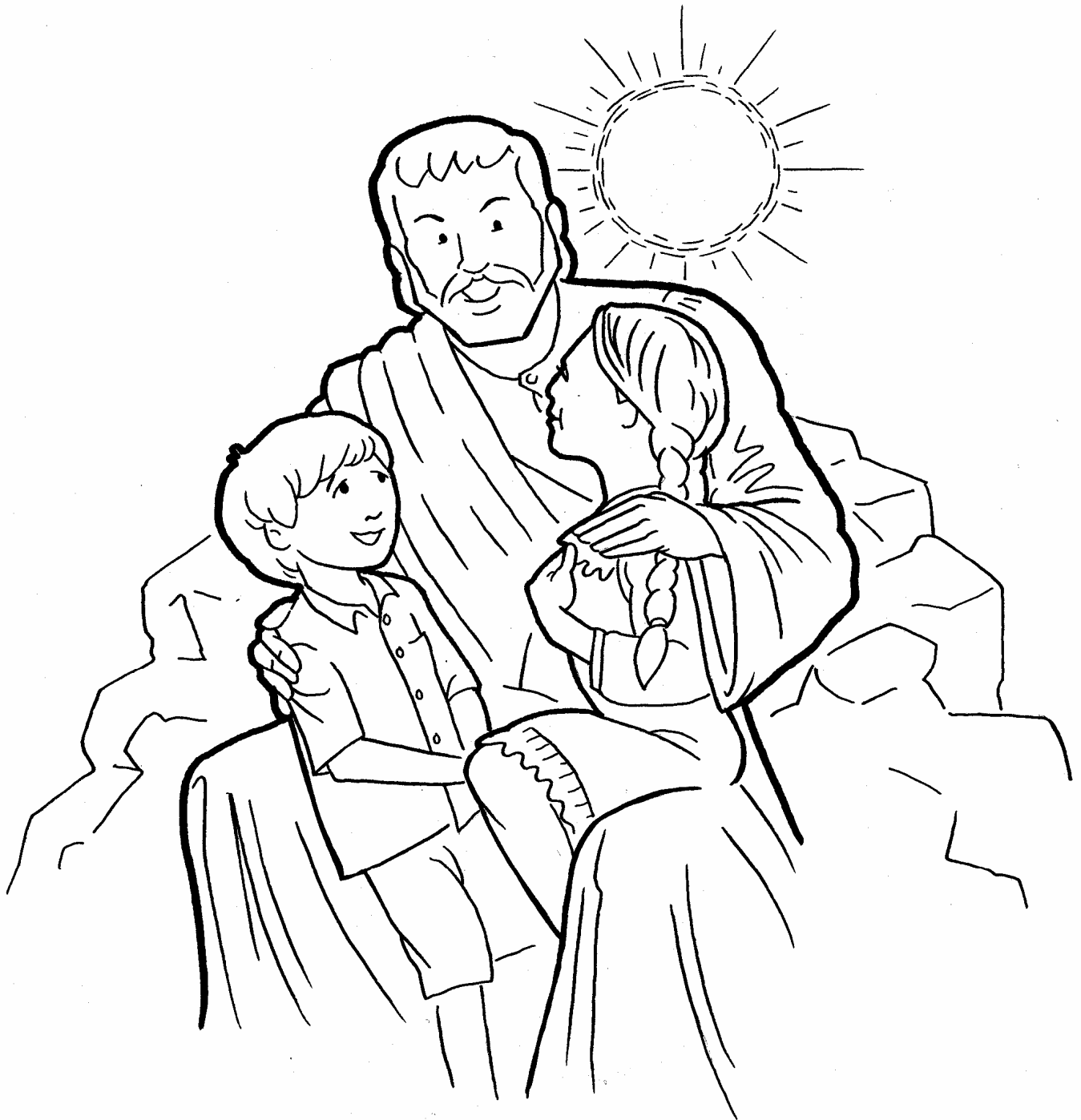
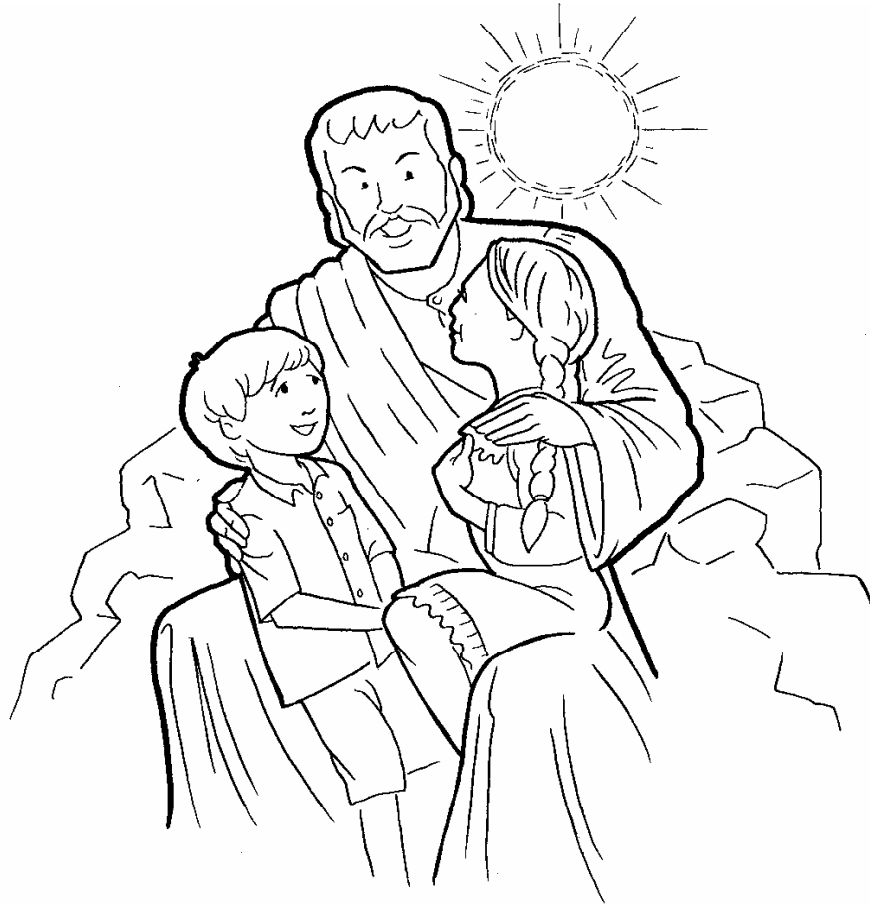

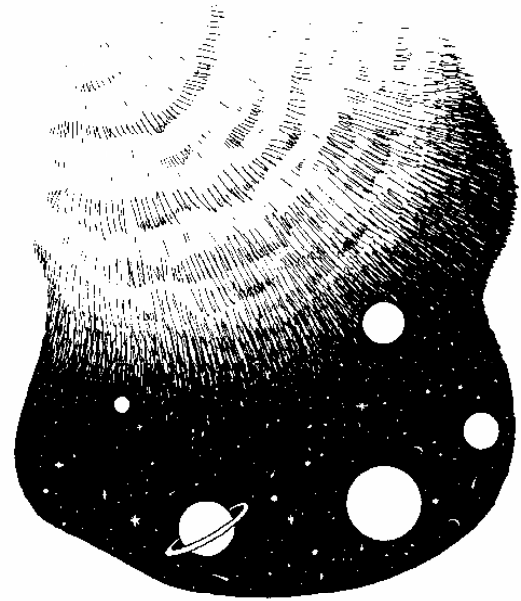

God made the whole world and all the things in it out of nothing! God is the only One strong enough to make something out of nothing!



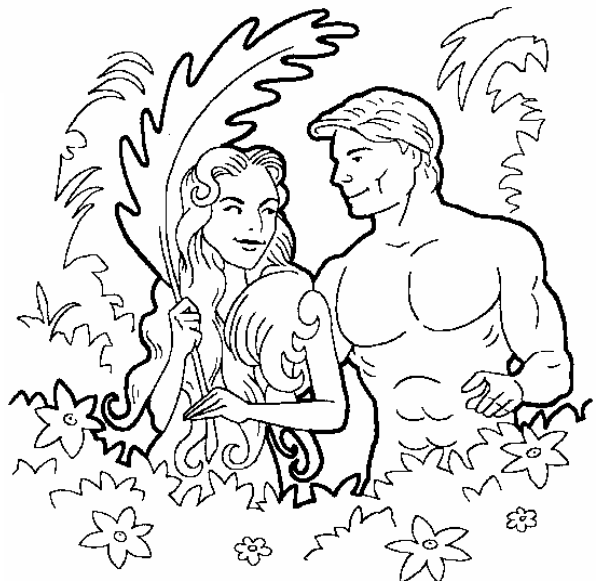

Eve gave the fruit to Adam and he also took a big bite of it. Adam and Eve had disobeyed God. They had sinned!

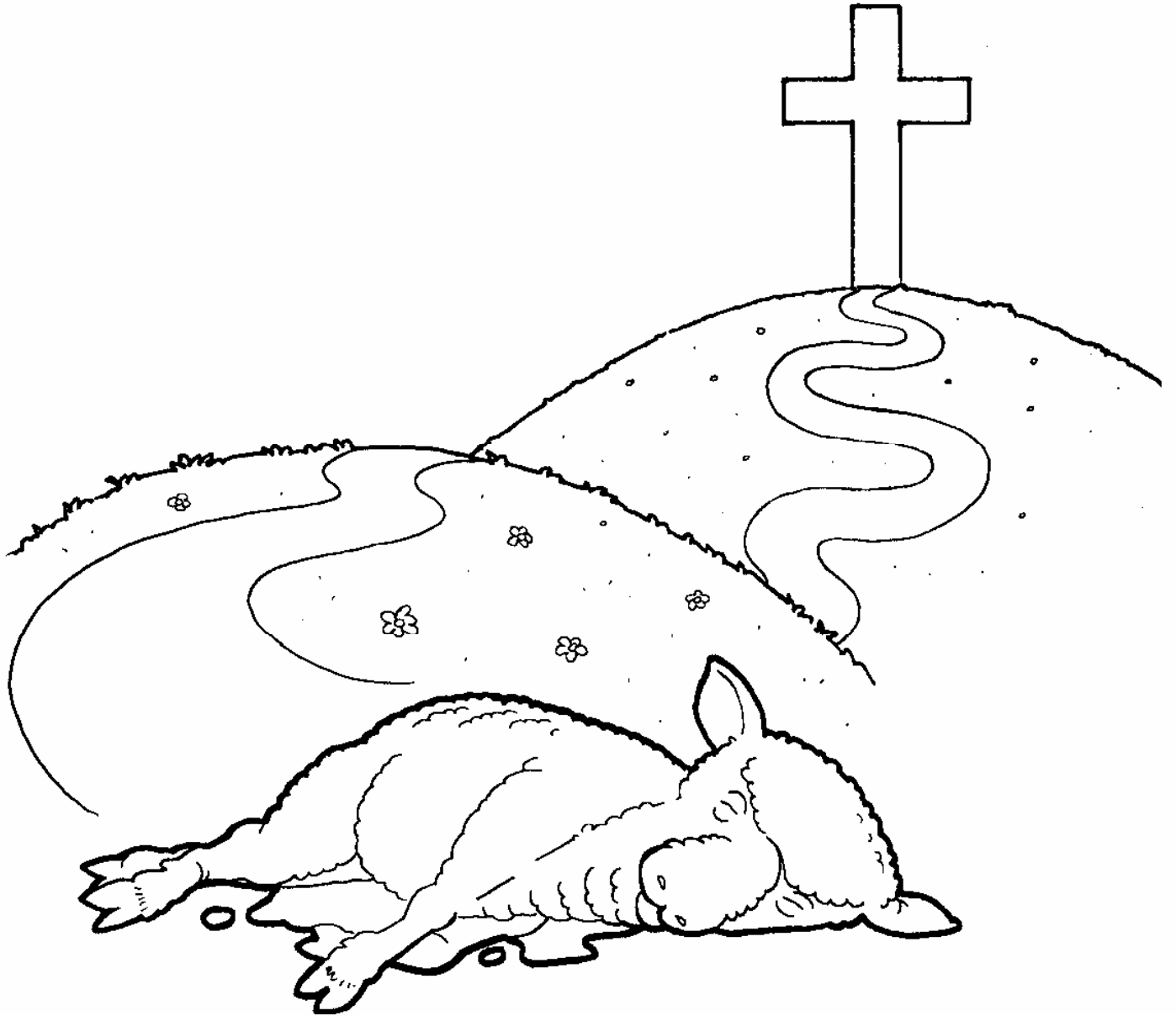


The Bible says that sin leads to death. But because God loved Adam and Eve He brought a lamb to die in their place. The lamb did not sin. The lamb did not deserve to die.

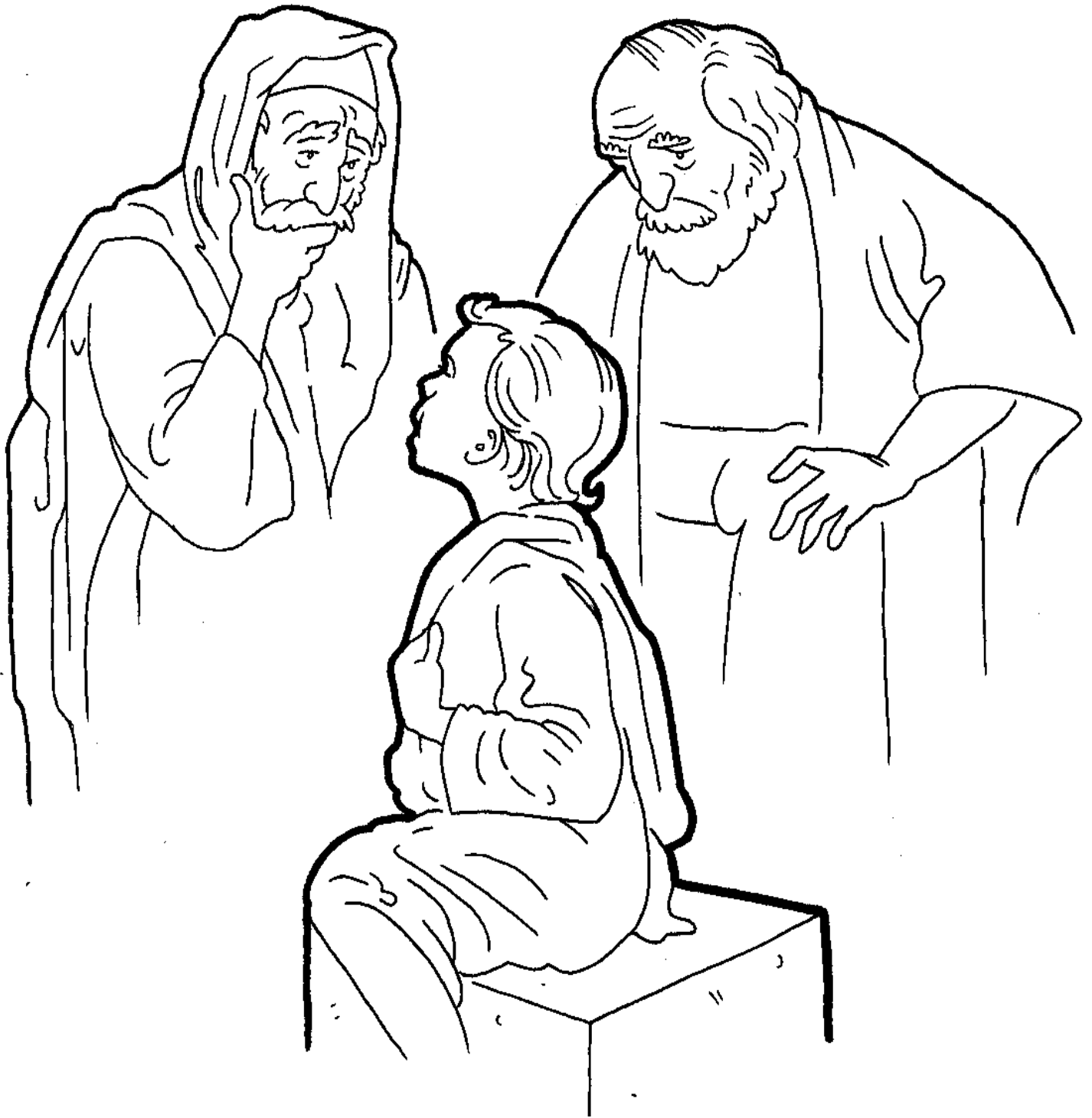


Just like Adam and Eve, you deserve to die for your sin. But because God loves you so much He sent Jesus Christ to die in your place.

One night Jesus went to a garden outside the city to pray to God.



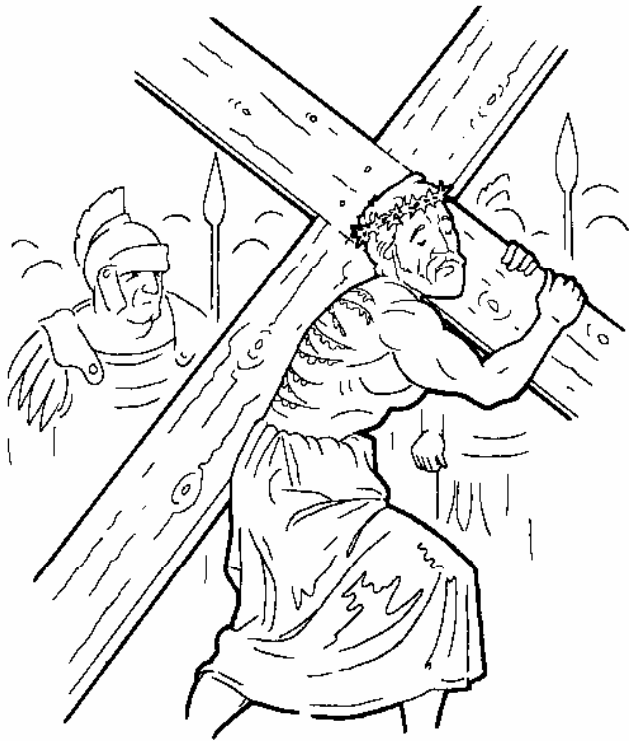
While He was in the garden praying, soldiers came and arrested Jesus.

They wanted this perfect, loving man to be put to death.

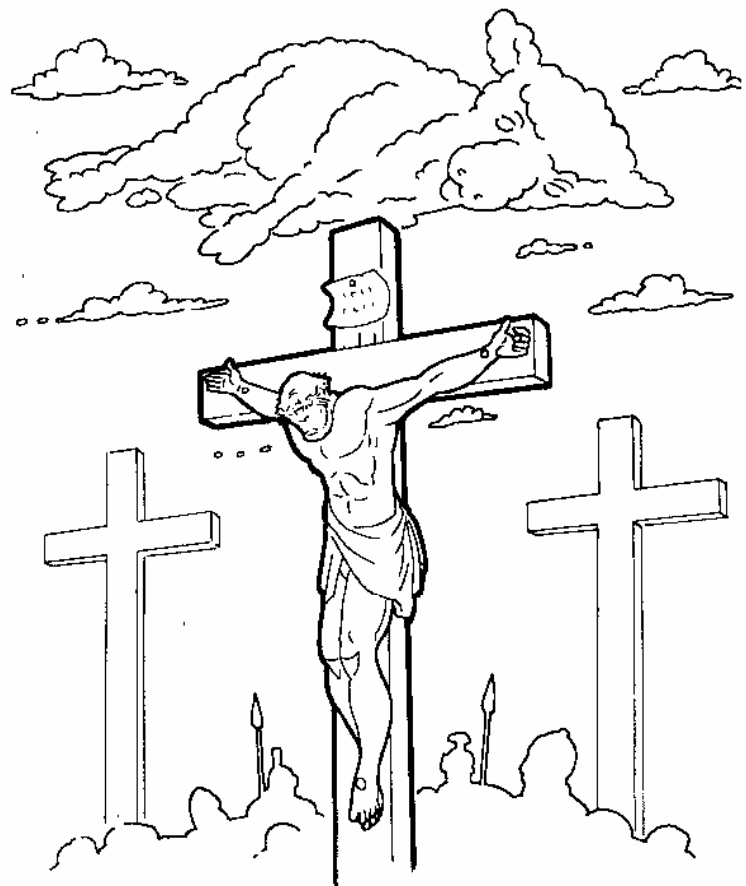




They made Jesus carry a heavy cross on his back and walk to a place called Golgatha.

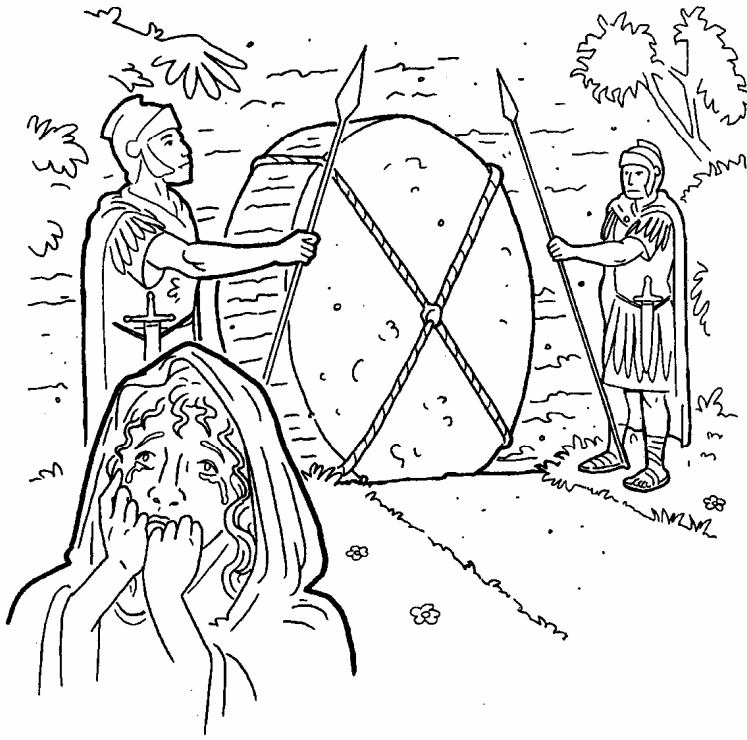
There they took Jesus, God's only Son, and they hung Him on the cross. They put nails through His hands and feet. They put a crown of thorns on His head.

His friends wept because they missed the man who was so kind and loving to them.

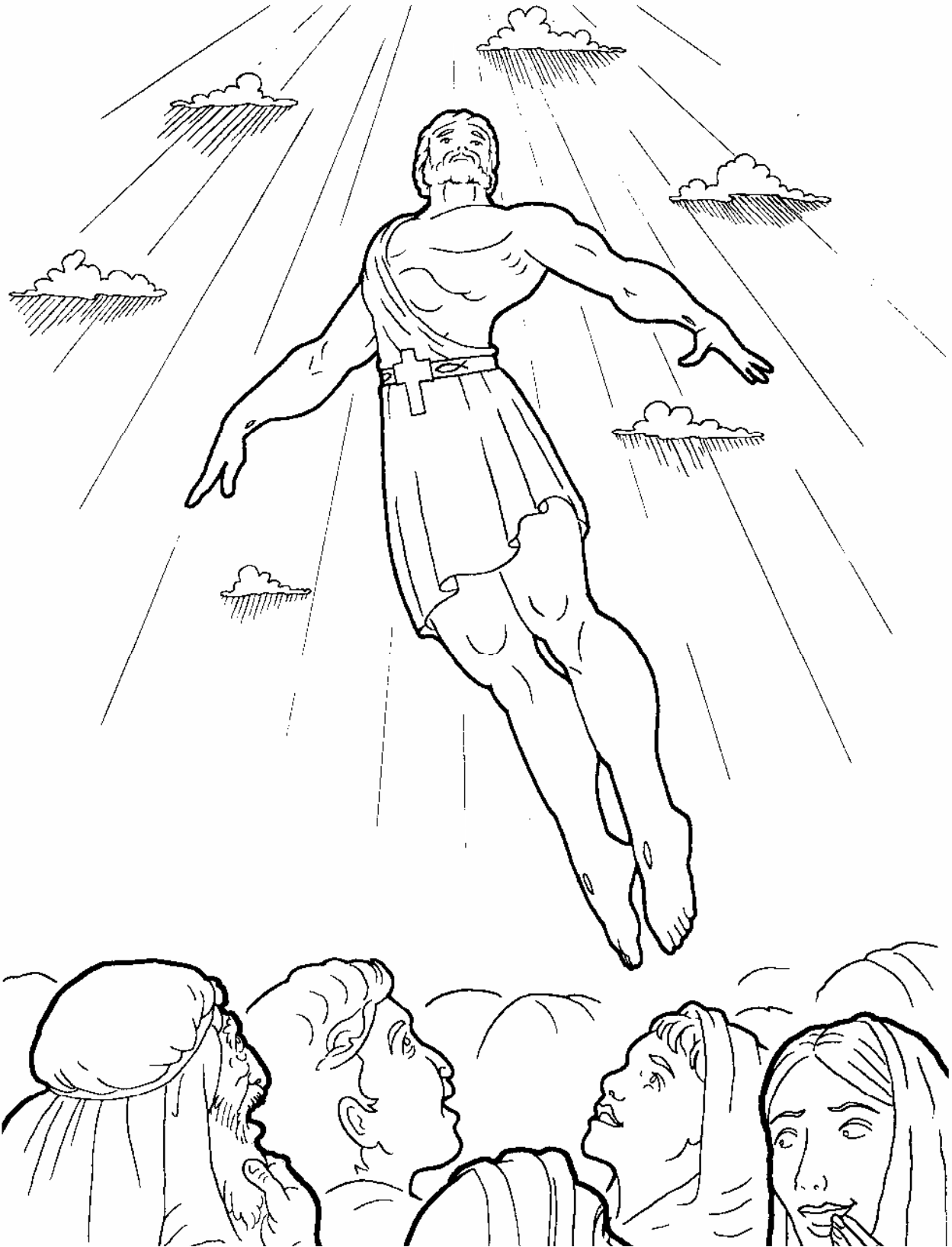
Jesus stayed in the tomb for 3 days and 3 nights. But then, an amazing thing happened...

On the morning of the third day the stone rolled away from the tomb.

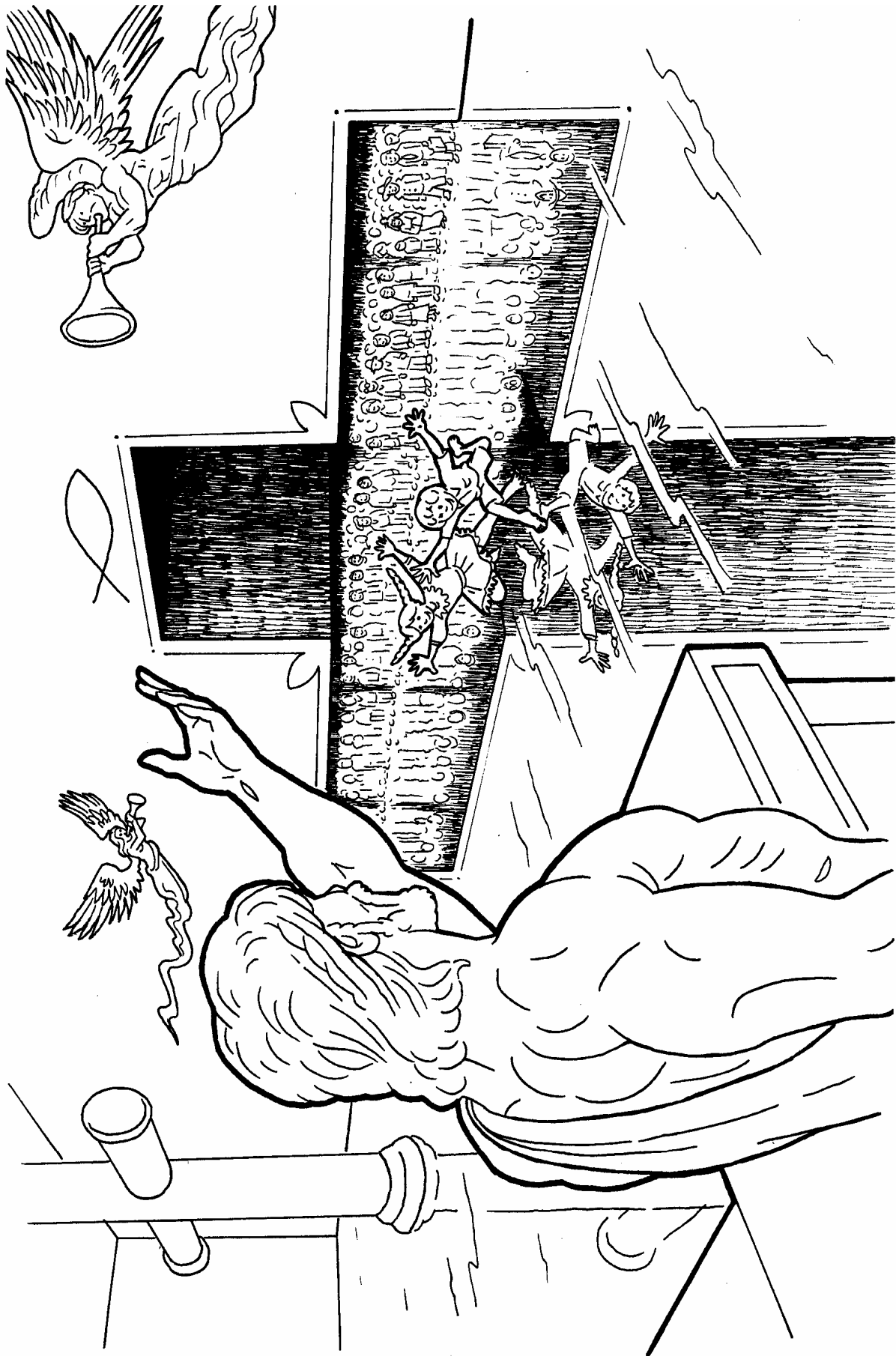
Jesus Christ rose from the dead and walked out of the tomb alive! Because Jesus is the Son of God He was stronger than death. He rose and lives again!
